



INTEGRITY TRAILERS INC. TRUE LINE AND PRIDE LINE LIMITED 3 YEAR WARRANTY

DURATION OF WARRANTY

Integrity Trailers Inc. has manufactured, tested and inspected in accordance with standard industry engineering requirements your True Line trailer. Your True Line or Pride Line trailer is warranted to the original owner to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 3 years from date of purchase. The obligation of this Warranty shall be limited to the replacement or repair of any parts which in the opinion of the Company shall be proved defective in materials or workmanship under normal use and service from the period commencing with the date of purchase. The Company reserves the right for final determination whether or not the trailer has been abused or misused by the Purchaser.

The following items are warranted for a period of one year from the date of purchase: Jack rams, Couplers, Jacks, Doors, Door and Glass Seals, Locks, electrical wiring, plumbing, fenders, fiberglass parts and paint.

This Warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may have other rights which vary from State to State.

LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

This Warranty does not extend to:

- 1) Integrity Trailers Inc. equipment which has been modified, altered or repaired without the express written consent of Integrity Trailers Inc.
- 2) Unreasonable use – including the failure to provide reasonable and necessary maintenance, including but not limited to improper torqued lug nuts.
- 3) Tires, wheels, axles, axle assemblies, suspension components, all appliances and any components of the Integrity Trailer unit which are warranted separately by the respective manufacturers of these components. These warranties are contained in the paperwork which should have been provided by the dealer.
- 4) Parts not supplied by Integrity Trailers Inc.
- 5) Certain parts which require replacement due to normal wear.
- 6) Product Rental.
- 7) Damage incurred from improper hook up.
- 8) Damage caused by heavy snowfall accumulations.
- 9) Tow Vehicle wiring or equipment.
- 10) Damage due to improper securement of cargo.
- 11) Any consequential damages for breach of this or any other warranty expressed or implied whatsoever. Repair or replacement under this Warranty is the only remedy available to the purchaser. Some States do not allow the exclusion or limitation of consequential or incidental damages.

HOW TO GET WARRANTY SERVICE

Each True Line and Pride Line trailer requires a Warranty registration. You should complete this registration with the dealer when you pick up your unit. To receive a warranty repair for your trailer, the unit must be delivered (charges prepaid) to the nearest Integrity Trailers Dealer or Integrity Trailers Manufacturing facility or as directed by the Company.
